Responses

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Our current call volume is currently remaining above the 5-year average. The call volume has helped with the ongoing department training for our new hires. In addition, it has created an opportunity for various medical skills to be demonstrated under the guidance of more senior staff.

Call volume is equally spread among each day of the week when looking at the entire year. The time of day where call volume is the lowest fall between 3:00 AM and 7:00 AM. The uniformity in call volume leaves little opportunity for peak call volume staffing increases.

In September, Lieutenants will review previous fire incident reports to ensure the fire loss information is complete and accurate. I recently reviewed the data and found some areas were not fully updated. This may result in the Fire loss numbers looking a little different.

In 2022 there were 204 times when we were on two or more emergency calls simultaneously. There were 18 times when we were on three or more simultaneous calls. This underscores the need for sufficient staffing daily.

Fire Safety Inspections

Since June 1, 2022, our part-time Fire Inspector has conducted more than 150 inspections. As a result, there are approximately 30 businesses that have completed the fire safety inspection process. In the process, we have updated emergency contacts and corrected dozens of violations that may have resulted in a fire.

Staffing

Currently, we have two team members off on worker's compensation. Of the two off due to injury, one is expected to be back near the end of the year. These injuries create day-to-day shortages, which result in overtime.

Currently, Shawn Roberson is Acting Lieutenant to provide additional managerial support and direction to the shift lacking a Lieutenant. Additionally, Acting Lieutenant Roberson has taken on other responsibilities mentoring new hires. On my last vacation, Roberson was the Duty Chief filling in as a Deputy Chief to assure operations continuity.

Currently, we have 15 full-time staff, including the fire chief, of which two are on worker compensation, and one is waiting to retest on certifications.

Equipment issues have slowed the ability to clear new staff members on the various equipment. In addition, trucks that are out of service or performing poorly does now allow for optimal training.

Several fire truck repair companies have reached out, offering service for our equipment. All prospective service providers would naturally be aware of the opportunity for continuous work due to the age of our fleet. The age of the fleet and intensity of use is an excellent indicator of the required maintenance. In addition, road conditions add additional stress to the large trucks.

We have also received information on available demo fire trucks through various suppliers. Most of the information received thus far is outside our price or specification range. We follow up daily on fire trucks that may be available to fill the immediate need and reduce money poured into repairs.

In other equipment news we are waiting on the third-party contractor to conduct SCAB Flow testing.
