

Notice that the following Ordinances were amended on 01-18-23 and properly voted on by Muskegon Heights City Council:

Sec. 3.20 - Outdoor storage.

Unless associated with an immediate construction project, all zoning uses shall not involve the storage of machinery, equipment, inoperable or unlicensed vehicles or trailers, lumber piles, crates, boxes, junk, debris or any other blight or blight-like materials in any yard or open area that is visible from the street, public right-of-way, alley or adjoining parcel or lot. • Sec. 86-81. - Prohibited growths; accumulations.

No owner of any parcel of land within the city or the agent of such owner shall permit on such parcel of land or upon any sidewalk abutting the land, or upon that portion of any street or alley adjacent to the land between the property line and the curb or traveled portion of such street or alley, any growth of weeds, grass or other rank vegetation to a greater height than eight inches, or any accumulation of dead weeds, trees, grass, leaves, or brush. Nor shall such owner or agent permit on such land poison ivy, ragweed or any other poisonous, noxious or unhealthful growths. (Code 1965, § 9.34; Ord. No. 02-533, 4-22-02; Ord. No. 08-567, 4-14-08)
